SUBJECT : Resumption of Soviet Testing

REFERENCE: Executive Memorandum No. 28, same subject, dtd 30 July 62

Your attention is called to the Executive Memorandum on this subject and you are reminded of the DCI's injunctions at the Executive Committee meeting on 25 July. This is to be considered as a directive to give the top priority toward securing any and all information possible on Soviet nuclear tests which should be promptly reported and analyzed and brought to the attention of the policy makers. I don't believe the importance that the DCI attaches to our coverage of this can be overemphasized.
