REFERENCE:

1. On 20 June 1962 the DCI met with Mr. Roger Hilsman who asked that the Department of State be advised of the findings of the referenced Task Force and be given copies of any reports. It is my understanding that this Task Force will report through the USIB, and consequently the Department of State will receive copies in that channel. However, will you please insure that State promptly receives any reports.

2. Would you arrange for bi-monthly reports on the Task Force, its composition, its progress and its future program. I would suggest that this be in the nature of a bi-monthly progress report addressed to the USIB through the DDCI.


