(Identification of major problems, gaps and deficiencies encountered by the DCI in the implementation of the President's memorandum of January 16, 1962, concerning coordination and guidance of the total U. S. foreign intelligence effort; and remedial actions taken or contemplated.)"

The DCI intends to write a memorandum himself on his work with JSIB members and the Defense and State Departments. Will you supply any additional thoughts that you might have.



a. "National intelligence estimating process. (Status and results of survey looking to possible improvements in organization, procedures and product.)"
