

Dear Cy:

I am writing concerning your letter to Nick Katzenbach, suggesting that we establish a joint State-Defense-CIA Study Group on the increased use of Cambodia by Communist forces operating in Viet-Nam.

Following your suggestion, I have asked Len Unger to serve as the State Department representative and Chairman of the Group. I understand that OSD and CIA representatives have now been appointed and that the Group expects to hold its first meeting this coming Friday afternoon, December 16.

I expect to follow the work of the Group myself and will be available at any point to consult with it.
