MEMORANDUM FOR THE HEADS OF EXECUTIVE
DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES:

On December 4th the President will honor a selected number of Federal career employees and officials for their special achievements in economy or cost reduction during the 10th anniversary year of the Government-wide incentive awards program.
