1. I would like to express my appreciation for the support given by the National Photographic Interpretation Center in the production of DIAM 55-3. As you know, this publication was requested by COMUSMACV and emphasized the immediate need for documentation and dissemination of photo intelligence data on Laos to aid the interpreter in making comprehensive readout of reconnaissance material on that area. The fact that we were able to meet this immediate need and compile a photographic interpretation key in the relatively short period of six months is due in large part to the wholehearted and unqualified support given by NPIC.

2. I would especially like to single out several NPIC elements and individuals who materially contributed their time and talents. The NPIC photo lab produced a large number of contact prints very expeditiously, yet maintained a high degree of quality. Also, [redacted] were most helpful in the support they provided.
