1. The Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) will conduct the Second World-Wide Intelligence Data Handling Systems Conference at Arlington Hall Station from 31 January through 4 February 1966. The Services, the Unified and Specified Commands, and the component organizations with automatic data processing installations are participating. If your Agency also would like to send observers, they would be most welcome.

2. Because of the limited capacity of the Conference facility, it has been necessary to limit the Department of Defense participants to two representatives per organization. SUBJECT: (U) Requirement for Special National Intelligence Estimate

TO: Director  
Central Intelligence Agency  
Washington, D.C. 20505

1. Confirming conversation at USIB meeting of 17 March, it is requested that a Special National Intelligence Estimate (SNIE) be processed at the highest priority with the following terms of reference: The probable reaction by North Korea and Communist China of the deployment of a South Korean Division to South Viet-Nam to participate in military base security activities, i.e., in static defense of vital base areas.

2. It is understood that the Board of National Estimates has already initiated action on this SNIE and that representatives will meet at 1430 on Thursday, 18 March, and that USIB is tentatively scheduled for Friday morning, 19 March.
