MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence

1. I saw [redacted] who was accompanied by his father, this afternoon. [redacted] is a pleasant youngster who graduated in January from the [redacted] with a degree in Accounting. He has completed one semester with the Institute for Foreign Trade, [redacted]. Although his scholastic record apparently was satisfactory, his draft board has cancelled his deferment. His job seeking is prompted by the imminence of a draft call. Inasmuch as he did not qualify under one of the excepted categories, I told him that we could not offer employment with draft exemption. If his interest continues, he will get in touch with us again upon completion of his military service and probably also his second degree from the Institute for Foreign Trade. I described the Career Trainee Program and think that he might be considered for it at that time.
