With reference to the query from your constituent, Mr. Koenig, we have no additional information beyond that furnished to the Space and Astronautics Committee early in May. We continue to believe that the Soviets attempted no manned space launches prior to the Gagarin flight.

All these articles appear to stem from information released by the Italian News Agency, Continentale, in December 1959. We have no reason to believe this information to be valid.
