TO: The Secretary of State

SUBJECT: Training for Friendly Police and Armed Forces in
Counter-Insurgency, Counter-Subversion, Riot
Control and Related Matters

The President has noted the reports received in response to NSAM No. 88 and requests that you make a continuing review in collaboration with the Secretary of Defense and the Director of Central Intelligence, of the over-all problem of United States support of friendly police and armed forces and their training in riot control, counter-subversion, counter-insurgency, and related operations. Such review should encompass general United States policies, the assignment of departmental responsibilities, and the general size and scope of United States programs. The general object should be to clarify and strengthen these policies and programs while minimizing duplication and conflicts.

The President further requests that you give him periodic reports on the results of the review, with recommendations of policy and courses of action included as appropriate. Latin America should be the first area covered by the review.

To the extent necessary, you should coordinate the review with National Security Action Memorandum No. 56 on the evaluation of paramilitary requirements, with the MAP and foreign aid programs, and with previous Overseas Internal Security Program reviews.
