Dear Senator Javits:

I have your note of 26 October 1960 forwarding a letter from [redacted] to you regarding the article in the Long Island Jewish Journal for August 1960 (returned herewith). As indicated in this article, similar material was contained in the Soviet publication New Times (#27 of July 1960). It was also published in the East German english-language periodical Democratic German Report, dated 19 August 1960. The detailed East German expose includes what purports to be a photostatic copy of the original German-language document prepared by the RSHA (Supreme Reich Security Office) on a discussion between Prince Max-Egon Hohenlohe and myself. The charges contained in these reports are identical with those in the Long Island Jewish Journal.

It is apparent that this material contains an additional item in the series of forgeries perpetrated upon the West by the Soviets in recent years, all of which claim to originate with "stolen" material from high-ranking American officials, or to be based upon recently-discovered material from German intelligence archives. The content of the document is patently spurious and there is no question but that the Soviets decided to release the material in a further effort to lend added support to their campaign to denigrate me as the Director of Central Intelligence.

These releases are based upon an obvious forgery and distortion of the facts. I trust that this information will be helpful to you in replying to [redacted] letter.
