MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Central Intelligence
ATTN: Chairman, Security Committee

Subject: Revision of DCID 11/2, Control of Dissemination
and use of Intelligence and Intelligence
Information

Reference: IBSEC-P-2/1, 22 January 1960

In response to the request contained in paragraph 3
above reference, it is recommended that the fourth and
fifth lines, paragraph 4b, Draft No. 5, DCID 11/2, be deleted
and the following substituted therefore:

Document: "The document shall not be disseminated
outside the States of the United States, except as
determined by the originator in order to satisfy special
conditions."

REASON: The above wording would permit the Director
for Intelligence, the Joint Staff, to secure
the authority from an originating agency to
disseminate such information to commanders
of unified and specified commands located
overseas in accordance with the following
justification:

a. Under the terms of the JCS ^{Chapter} ~~Chapter~~ the Director
for Intelligence, the Joint Staff, has the responsibility
of providing intelligence support to commanders of unified
and specified commands.

b. These commanders are senior officers of broad back-
grounds and experience who are in positions to influence
military operations within their respective areas of responsi-
bility. They may be required by circumstances to act on
their own initiative in time of emergency.

c. No security hazard would be created since the
JCS and DIA review(s) headquarters of unified and specified commands overseas
completed.

d. Geographic location of a proposed addressee should not of itself be a bar to dissemination if the addressee had a valid need to know the information and can protect it adequately.
