Dear Allen:

As you may know, we are in the process of altering the character of the Voice of America's Munich Radio Center. Briefly, we propose to move programming operations to Washington and to convert the Center into a special events servicing unit. This means that on or about September 30 most of our non-American employes in Munich will be released.

I bring this matter to your attention in the belief that Radio Liberation and Radio Free Europe would find among our local people many highly skilled broadcasters who are expert in various languages, including some of the more unusual ones. If your Agency could assist in having as many as possible of these people picked up by other international broadcasters, I am sure it would be in the interest of our Government, especially since most of our local employes are stateless persons.

I should be very grateful for any help you can offer in this matter.


