Dear General George:

As you know, the Central Intelligence Agency is now at work with representatives of the Intelligence Advisory Committee preparing the National Intelligence Estimates required by you in your Net Evaluations Studies. These intelligence estimates I am told will be completed shortly and in time to satisfy your needs.
