Dear Allen:

The enclosures may interest you and particularly Fred Smith's suggestion for a two-way international press conference when the NPA case study of the Philippine-American Life Insurance Company's operations is released to the public.

As far as I know, such a thing has never been done before ~~but~~ <sup>and</sup> if we can pull it off and everything clicks, it should be a howling success. Because Magsaysay has already expressed his unqualified approval of the study and of the splendid contributions of the company studied, we can be reasonably certain that he will not say anything that would strike a sour note. Moreover, we would have a competent moderator at the New York dinner who could side track any questions that might be asked that might embarrass Magsaysay.
