

I have your letter of 24 September 1956 expressing your interest in associating with our Agency following your prospective retirement in July 1957.

As you may know, the Director of Central Intelligence is authorized by law to employ not more than fifteen longevity-retired officers of the armed services. Those retired for combat or service-incurred disability are excluded from the provisions of the dual employment law.

From your letter it appears that you are eligible to retire for longevity and would, if employed by us, come within the quota of fifteen. We would be glad to accept your formal application against the possibility that a suitable opening might be available when you retire, and will be glad to send you the necessary papers. However, based on a review of our current situation, this appears unlikely.

Your interest in the work of this Agency and your offer to be of service is appreciated.
