25X1 On Monday, December 10th, I discussed current status and proposals for future [redacted] operations as covered in [redacted] with members of the Special Group informally and prior to the Executive Committee meeting which assembled at 5:30 in the evening.

Recommendations A and B were approved, and Mr. Bundy reported that the subject had been discussed with higher authority and therefore there was no need to again refer the matter.

25X1 Recommendations C and D were held in abeyance subject to further consideration by CIA regarding the security implications of an operation in [redacted]

25X1 For your information, at a subsequent discussion with Alexis Johnson, he raised the question as to whether security of U-2 over-flights was a matter of any particular concern to us if the [redacted] participated in this activity, as anticipated in C and D. I think this is a point well worth evaluating in connection with CIA consideration of [redacted] security problem.

25X1 Such steps should be taken at once to implement A and B, including notification to our Ambassador and such talks with the [redacted] as are appropriate.

Upon completion of the second of the four authorized flights, recommendation for additional flights should be made to me for presentation to the Special Group.
