Dear Joe:

Following up on your letter of 5 June to Mr. McCone and the first meeting that we had on June 8, I just want to let you know that the complete facilities of the Central Intelligence Agency are available to you and staff members of your organization for continued follow-up discussions of areas of mutual interest.

We continue to receive requests from operational units of the armed services for CIA liaison officers in the fields of paramilitary and counter-insurgency operations. Note that these come from operational headquarters rather than from the military intelligence community. This is quite natural since we here in the Agency are engaged in operations as well as the collection and evaluation of pure intelligence.

We have now completed a static display of much of our sterilized drop equipment as well as agent equipment for clandestine and covert activities. I think your people would find this interesting, especially those engaged in research and development activities. The classification is Secret and the contact for viewing this equipment is Mr. [redacted] (Code 143, Ext. [redacted]). It is almost identical with the display that we put on at Eglin Air Force Base for the President.

I would appreciate hearing from you or your people as to what other ways I may follow up on Mr. McCone's basic letter of 22 May.


