MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

1. On 12 June 1963 I called Dr. Brockway McMillan, Assistant Secretary of the Air Force, to advise him that the DCI thinks it is a fine idea for [redacted] to be assigned to take over Dr. Scoville's duties as Deputy Director, NRO. I told Dr. McMillan that [redacted] would be available as soon as he completed the Purcell Panel report, which I believed would be today. In response to Dr. McMillan's query, I stated that [redacted] has agreed to this assignment. I also informed him that Mr. McCone will advise Mr. Gilpatric of this when he sees him later this afternoon.

2. I told Dr. McMillan that all administrative arrangements would be made by CIA and, in response to his query, advised Dr. McMillan that [redacted] primary office would be in the Pentagon where he would "get right in with you and be your Deputy." I also stated that [redacted] will not assume Dr. Scoville's Agency responsibilities, but would be assigned to DD/R and work directly under Dr. Scoville's replacement who has not yet been selected. In this connection, I stated that [redacted] would be Dr. McMillan's Deputy and that although arrangements within the Agency are still a little obscure, we are not concerned about the rationale of the chain of command within the Agency and assured him that we can take care of that without any problem.

3. Dr. McMillan stated it would appear that the new DD/R would not be the Director of [redacted] but that it would be Colonel [redacted] or someone else. I said that we had not as yet tackled that problem with Mr. McCone, adding that that would probably be the best way so that [redacted] would really be Dr. McMillan's Deputy; in that way, [redacted] can ride herd on [redacted] regardless of who in the Agency gets that assignment.
