



2. McGeorge Bundy has issued NSAM #267 which establishes a review committee on which the DCI will sit to advise on the desirability of any AEC or DOD proposed nuclear tests which might result in accusations of a US violation of the Test Ban Treaty.

Other members of the committee which will be chaired by Bundy are: Rusk, McNamara, Seaborg, Taylor, Foster and Wiesner "or their designated representatives."
