SUGGESTED TOPICS

- I. Community ^(US/B) composed of CIA, DIA, State, NSA, FBI, AEC.
- A. Also have DNRO when matters of concern to him are discussed. Army, Navy, and Air Force have contributing observers.
- II. Board chaired by DCI as overall coordinator of National Intelligence Effort.
- A. USIB -- a sort of Board of Directors with DCI as Chairman.
- B. Two of its most important functions are (1) NIE's; and, (2) PNIO's.
- III. In times past, one of USIB's biggest problems has been developing a management concept which permits follow-through actions on USIB decisions.
- A. DCI has put major emphasis on this. Appointment of Bross in his Staff as DD/NIPE.
- IV. USIB and the Community make use of certain major intelligence efforts such as NSA, NRO, NPIC, [redacted]
- A. Large Community in excess of [redacted] Total budget estimated at between [redacted] annually depending upon intelligence versus reconnaissance.
- V. As DDCI, I stand ready to act as DCI at any time (which is frequent -- DCI currently in Europe).
- A. DCI has delegated virtually all of his authorities to me and has specifically requested that I act as a sort of General Manager of the Agency.
- B. This does not relieve DCI of a very active role in the Agency.
1. Project approvals.
2. Approval of budgets, etc.
- VI. DCI, of course, is the President's intelligence advisor and sits as such in all meetings of the NSC.
