Morning Meeting of 22 July 1965

25X1 There was a brief discussion of the DDI's trip [redacted].  
He will leave tomorrow and has coordinated purposes of his trip with Bill Bundy.

25X1 DCI inquired about the status of the statement he has requested on the value of interdicting supply routes between Hanoi and China. DDI said this will be done by the end of the day.

DDI reported a White House request from Chet Cooper. The President asked him to request CIA to provide an inventory of troop units of friendly countries which could be made available for combat duty in Vietnam. DDI observed that answering this request will be difficult but response will be forwarded today.

DDI described a new publication -- a handbook covering various world areas. They are essentially summaries of the NIS. The first to be published deals with Africa.

DDI tabled with DCI a memo describing the extent of Agency research and analysis on Sino Soviet relations.

DDI noted that a cable has been received on the second and last of the Harriman-Kosygin conversations.

25X1 [redacted] press reports of a captured document in Vietnam alleged to be instructions to the Viet Cong to return to NVN. Validity of the document is questionable. MACV is studying a copy.

25X1 DDS reported on the tour [redacted] recently made by Ambassador Kidder who is the Director of the Interdepartmental Seminar.

deSilva reported on the status of testing of the chemical substance which can indicate that a person has fired a weapon. Tests to date show it to be 50 to 65 percent effective over an 18-hour period. Two weeks of additional testing will take place. Cost and production figures will be available by the end of the two-week period.

IG reported [redacted] on the Hill today to brief Committee staff member Michaels on auditing procedures.

Houston reported on a device suggested by an attorney which may be of use to the FAA in detecting bombs placed in luggage on commercial airlines.

Bross reported on conversations he had with D/NRO who agrees to take no action [redacted] pending a report by the [redacted] Panel.

DDS&T reported that Far East weather is bad and no TACKLE flights are imminent. The first bucket of the current CORONA mission is planned for recovery tonight.

DDS&T noted that he will meet with Harold Brown today to discuss backscatter radar in the Far East. He will also discuss the system for [redacted] In respect to the latter, DCI's guidance was that Brown should be told we would like to proceed with development of the equipment if DOD concurs. DOD expertise is to be requested to help in the development.

Actions:

1. DCI requested a study of various foreign weapons and ammunition as related to the chemical substance intended to disclose that a person has fired a weapon. The purpose is to determine whether the substance is useful in all cases. (DDP)

2. With regard to the Agency plan for augmentation of programs, personnel and funds for Vietnam, DCI asked that a supporting paper be prepared as soon as possible. Our plan is to be explained to Ambassador Lodge. It may have to be submitted to the 303 Committee. It will be taken up with BOB. DDP and Colby are to discuss the plan with McGeorge Bundy. (DDP)

25X1 3. DCI directed that a formal CIA agreement with NSA be executed, to insure a joint CIA/NSA role [redacted] (DDS&T and NIPE)

4. DCI requested that Ambassador Sullivan, who will be in the building today, be briefed on the Agency plans for augmentation in Vietnam. (DDP)
