Morning Meeting of 22 July 1966

Duckett briefed the Executive Committee on the Soviet ABM program and its relationship to U. S. weapons systems and noted problems related to intelligence collection and production of finished intelligence on this subject.

~~Proctor reported that Bromley Smith has requested a detailed evaluation comparing the [redacted] report on the [redacted] program with the NIE. Limited dissemination of this evaluation will be given to top State and Defense Department officials.~~

Proctor discussed the requirements levied in connection with the [redacted] on Soviet missile and space activities.

Proctor noted that General Carroll had discussed the DIA program [redacted] with a Senate subcommittee. (See Action 1)

[redacted] for Godfrey reported that new instructions have been issued by the Defense Department for our forces in Vietnam regarding bombing and military operations in the DMZ area and referred to today's CIB item on the oil situation in North Vietnam. He observed that the demonstrations in Peking are apparently designed to impress the U. S. and reported that the Supreme Soviet meeting scheduled for 2 August will be closely followed.

DD/S reported that the study prepared for the President by the committee chaired by John Macy on the use of the polygraph has apparently been leaked but has not yet appeared in the press. DD/S also referred to the investigation planned by Senator Ervin into the [redacted]

DD/S&T reported that, as a result of his recent conversations with high [redacted] officials, the status of [redacted] training has been improved. He noted that [redacted] DD/S&T discussed the study by [redacted] on the intelligence requirements process.
