Kent reported that a memo to holders of the Dominican Republic SNIE will be out today. He noted a request from Rostow for an NIE on Panama. He expressed his best wishes to the DCI and congratulated him on his activities as DCI during the past year. The DDCI and others seconded his remarks.

Bannerman reported that Admiral Caldwell of CINCLANT will visit Headquarters sometime after 15 July. He noted that the price of haircuts had risen to \$2.00 in the Headquarters barber shop.

Earman commented that in his capacity as the Acting Executive Director-Comptroller, he had noted a vast improvement in the paperwork which flowed to his desk. The DCI recalled some of his experience in cutting down paperwork while with the Polaris program.

Houston noted that the Senate had unanimously confirmed the nomination of Mr. Richard Helms to be Director of Central Intelligence. He reported on a conversation that he had with Jim Cross, the Executive Officer of IDA.
