Morning Meeting of 2 May 1966

DDCI was in the chair.

DD/I reported that the first of the interdirectorate orientation briefings took place on 28 April. The DD/I briefed DD/S officers on the DD/I. The briefing lasted two and one-half hours.

DDCI referred to the Agency proposal concerning family visits to the Headquarters building. There are certain problems in this connection. Whether or not it will be approved is uncertain. The DDCI intends to discuss this with the DCI.

DDCI noted recent adverse press statements on the implications of the [] case. DDCI noted several factual points about this case which may serve as useful background to Agency employees: (1) a straight-forward attempt was made to settle this case out of court, as is typical of most court cases of this kind; (2) the Agency refused to consider any sort of payoff or bribe for [] (3) the Agency obtained the services of two excellent lawyers; (4) the Department of Justice was kept in touch with all the developments in this case right along.
