MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

Morning Meeting of 14 April 1966

DDCI was in the chair.

DD/I noted that Eugene Black plans a trip to Southeast Asia during May to sound out Asian leaders on a Southeast Asia development plan.

DD/I tabled copies of biographic sketches prepared yesterday on key South Vietnamese generals involved in the overthrow of Diem and now being mentioned as possible successors to Ky.

Godfrey tabled a working aid prepared by OCI describing Juan Bosch's political party. Godfrey also observed that OCI will be issuing Sitreps frequently today and tomorrow during the Presidential visit to Mexico. (See Action 1)

25X1 Kent referred to the ONE memo prepared on [redacted] and [redacted] and noted that there was disagreement within the Agency and within the Community on the thrust of the paper. It was agreed that at USIB today, where the paper is on the agenda, a decision should be made to ask that the paper be redone, coordinated, and perhaps issued as a SNIE. Bross noted the importance of providing sufficient official status to the paper to permit it to have maximum use in policy consideration. 25X1

25X1 [redacted] noted receipt of a memo from George Denney of INR asking for USIB briefings of Soviet world-wide SIGINT capabilities. It was agreed that at USIB this morning the DCI would note receipt of the memo and ask NSA to prepare the briefings.

25X1 [redacted] reported that the briefing book on OXCART deployment is ready for dissemination after attachment of an addendum which would make the point that the latest U-2 coverage provided exploitable photography on only two of the eighteen targets overflown in the China border area.


