



[redacted] reported on the NRO ExCom meeting yesterday afternoon which apparently went very well. The DCI commended Dr. Wheelon's briefings on various topics in the NRO field. The DCI re-emphasized his view that the primary element in the levying of tasks within the NRO was the national interest of the country. (See Action item 2)

The DCI commended deSilva for his back-up work at the President's Board meeting yesterday.

Earman reported on his visit to the documents storage facilities at [redacted]. He said he intended to examine the requirement to maintain security files on all ex-Agency employees for 125 years.

Houston noted that Senator Symington has now decided to include Saigon in his trip and he will be briefed by Dr. Cline on Friday. The DCI noted that he wants to sit in on this briefing. He also noted that Senator Hayden was going on a trip but did not desire a briefing.



Bross noted that he would talk with Henry Rowen in BOB this afternoon concerning program reviews.

25X1 The DCI noted that the 303 Committee had not approved the track for [redacted] but did urge that the program be retained. DDP suggested that a track for an entirely different area be developed [redacted] and the DCI agreed. 25X1

25X1 FitzGerald noted that the Embassy in Cairo believed that the Amin case would be shelved indefinitely and that a Pak official had absolved CIA of any involvement in the Indian attack on Pakistan. He noted that at a future Morning Meeting a briefing would be presented on the [redacted]

ACTIONS:

25X1 1. The DCI requested a memorandum estimating reaction to the inclusion of two POL targets in North Vietnam in connection with [redacted] target lists. This would include POL targets within the sanctuary area as well as the entire country. (Dr. Kent as soon as possible) *DONE*

2. DCI requested that the briefing of the 303 Committee on the OX deployment be deferred until after Secretary McNamara has been briefed. (Dr. Wheelon in the course of the day)

3. Executive Director suggested that at a future Morning Meeting *DONE* a briefing be given by DD/S on [redacted] [redacted] 25X1

4. The DCI noted an article in the New York Times which reported that a group of private citizens was urging a moratorium on the U. S. development of an anti-missile missile. The DCI would like a memo on the Soviet efforts in this field, complete with pictures as well as an estimate of reactions of U. S. development of an all-out NIKE-X deployment. (Dr. Kent as soon as possible.)
