10 August 1965

1. The Director asked me to advise him whether he had an option in choosing between California and Virginia as his legal residence and, if so, which would be more advantageous to him. (I asked John Warner to research this.)

2. I advised the Director of the revolting development about a limousine for him and told him that we would find out how much it would cost to modify a sedan before making a positive recommendation.

3. I met with [redacted] and Bob Bannerman to discuss the Director's interest in having some of our personnel attend FBI schools. It was agreed that, subject to Mr. Hoover's final approval, in which [redacted] saw no problem, we would send a man to their twelve-week course at the National Academy. This is a course which is attended by forty to fifty police officers, sheriffs, etc., from all over the United States and sometimes four or five foreigners. We will send somebody from the Office of Security and will not attempt to put him under cover.

4. I talked to [redacted] who was recommended to Dick Helms by [redacted] and will see him at 1400 hours on Thursday, 12 August.

5. Tom Karamessines called me about a grade GS-11 employee traveling to Europe as a part of the DD/I orientation program. I told him that I thought I would question this program when the DD/I budget is examined.
