In the specially-classified portion of the minutes of the Special Group meeting of 27 July 1961, it was stated that the suggestion had been made by higher authority that the pilot of the

I was later informed that after the U-2 incident of May 1960, the decision had been made that in the future pilots of this type of aircraft would be instructed to give only name, date and place of birth, U. S. address, and CIA affiliation (civilian), if captured. In addition, the DCI raised a question as to whether it would be

(Mr. Dulles did not feel, however, that this was a particularly weighty point one way or the other.)

In a further discussion with General Taylor, he took the position that the restricted briefing explained above would not be inconsistent with the earlier suggestion. This suggestion had been
