Mr. Wolf reported that Senator Bridges had intimated that we would get our \$20,000,000 for building. Also Mr. Saunders is convinced that the Bureau of the Budget is committed to giving us the additional \$18,000,000 if the Appropriations Committee passes the \$20,000,000. The DCI said that 1,600,000 square feet appeared to be too much. We should try to cut it down to 1,000,000 feet and build the type of building that could be expanded.
