The DCI raised a question as to the terms under which INS proposed to install a ticker in CIA as noted in the Log. Mr. Wolf said that he would inquire into this.

The DCI inquired respecting project [Redacted] and after some discussion stated that he would not approve it until it had received the approval of PSB. In this connection, the DCI noted that he was not prepared to spend [Redacted] for a project unless he had some assurance that we were prepared to go forward in subsequent years.

In answer to an inquiry by the DCI Mr. Wisner reported that the OPC books for PSB would be ready for consideration by the DCI Monday next. Mr. Dulles would look them over over the weekend.


