Director's Meeting

Thursday, 27 December 1951

PRESENT: General Smith, Messrs. Dulles, Jackson, Wolf, Wisner, [redacted] Becker. 25X1

Mr. Wolf raised briefly the status of Col. [redacted]. The DCI approved employing Col. [redacted] at once and noted that there were a number of positions in which he might be useful. Mr. Wolf indicated that Col. [redacted] would like to have [redacted] and the DCI also indicated that he could be used in Col. Edwards' shop. 25X1 25X1

Mr. Dulles handed the Director a copy of the TIMES containing the Pope's recent encyclical respecting the political position of the Church which, it was felt, represented a step toward neutralism.

There was a brief discussion of the NSC Southeastern Asia paper and the DCI indicated that he wished to study it further. The DCI also indicated some dissatisfaction with the policy of passive defense, but noted that this involved major questions of policy which was not properly CIA's field. In connection with this discussion, the DCI referred to recent reports indicating a considerable build-up affecting Indochina and the other southeast Asian areas.





Mr. Wolf referred to the discussion at an earlier meeting to the effect that CIA had requested four Naval personnel by name. Upon investigation he had found that only one of these people had been requested by CIA by name, the names of the other three having been inserted by the Naval personnel office before the request had been seen by Adm. Johnson, who, naturally, assumed that CIA had supplied these names. Mr. Dulles requested that he be given the information on that so he could explain it to Adm. Johnson.

Mr. Wolf reported respecting the CIA personnel turnover in December. Throughout the Agency the percentage was 1.1%. The highest Offices were *overt* Training and Medical. All of the sensitive offices were under 2%.


