





The Director stated that he had discussed this matter with the President on 25 January and there was no objection to our proceeding along the lines indicated in the above referred to message. Mr. Dulles noted that he was keeping State informed of our progress in this matter.

c. Noted that George Kennan was in town and would like to see the Director. The DCI indicated his approval and stated he would get in touch with Mr. Kennan through Mr. Webb's office.
