Deputies' Meeting

Tuesday, 10 June 1952

PRESENT: General Smith, Messrs. Dulles, Wisner, Wolf, Becker, [redacted] 25X1

General Smith: 25X1

25X1 a. Briefly discussed a State cable from [redacted] concerning [redacted] 25X1
visit to China. Mr. Wisner noted that CIA and State had undertaken to interrogate
as many of the people possible who had accompanied her and, in this connection,
said that (1) [redacted] had just returned to the U.S. and apparently had had
opportunity to secure some information from [redacted] (2) [redacted] 25X1
was scheduled to arrive in [redacted] today and had been instructed to obtain such 25X1
additional information as he could.

b. Asked if it was desired that [redacted] become a member of the NCFE 25X1
Board. Mr. Dulles said that it was and Mr. Wisner undertook to follow up on
this.

25X1 c. Referred to the first item in today's Log and, after some discussion,
stated that it appeared that our people were pushing this matter too hard and
were, in all probability, making a nuisance of themselves. [redacted] noted 25X1
he believed [redacted] was attempting to "repay us" for not advising him
"sufficiently in advance" of [redacted] The Director 25X1
said that (1) [redacted] should be advised that if we were unable to send our
people to [redacted] without making a great show of such visits, we would skip
visiting [redacted] altogether; (2) in the final analysis, it was no more incumbent
upon the [redacted] to give us full details on the visit of their people to the
U.S. than it was upon us to advise [redacted] on our visits 25X1

Mr. Dulles:

a. Briefly reported on the discussion held at yesterday's NSC Senior
Staff meeting on the Berlin Paper and noted that (1) this paper had not been
substantially changed since the DCI last saw it; (2) it would be ready for
discussion at the NSC meeting tomorrow.

25X1 b. Stated that [redacted] had been successful in his negotiations
with the [redacted] 25X1

25X1 c. Briefly reported on certain problems concerning NCFE and, after some
discussion, the Director stated consideration should be given to using [redacted] 25X1
[redacted] in connection with the administration of this program.
Mr. Dulles said [redacted] already had this matter under consideration.
