

DEPUTIES' MEETING

Tuesday, 30 June 1953

PRESENT: Messrs. Dulles, Wolf, Amory, Helms, Kirkpatrick, Colonel White
and Mr. [redacted]

Mr. Dulles:

a. Noted he had received calls from [redacted] and J. C. King
respecting Pat Johnston's request for operational information and asked
Mr. Helms to look into this. Mr. Helms noted that Mr. Wisner designated
him as point of contact with Johnston and undertook to discuss this
problem with him on 1 July.

b. Referred to a cable from [redacted] respecting exchange
of correspondence between him ([redacted]) and [redacted]
[redacted] and asked Mr. Helms to advise the Senior
Representative [redacted] that Headquarters approves the action he had
taken in this matter. The Director also asked that this reply include
instructions that [redacted] cable be brought to the attention of General
Cabell and Mr. [redacted] upon their arrival in [redacted]

c. The Director noted a cable to Mr. Wisner respecting [redacted]
future activities and after some discussion indicated his intention of
further discussing this matter at the PSB Luncheon tomorrow.

d. Referred to a cable from the Senior Representative [redacted]
[redacted] regarding his views on the possible intelligence failure
respecting the release of the North Korean POW's, and handed to DD/I and
Acting DD/P his proposed reply for their comment.

e. Asked Mr. Helms to determine what newspapers and periodicals
are furnished our foreign stations, noting it was his opinion that some
procedure should be established whereby these stations would receive some
material of this nature on a timely basis.
