





b. Noted that in a conversation with [redacted] he had recommended that [redacted] return to Headquarters to discuss the CIA/CIC Political Center [redacted]. Mr. Wisner said he had the Director's views on this, that such a visit was premature and undertook to discuss the matter further with [redacted]. The Director stated that while he had no objection to [redacted] returning he would leave the decision to DD/P.

recommended that: (1) this analysis be held in abeyance until the new Congress convenes; (2) at that time we only attempt to keep tab on the more important statements such as that recently made by Congressman Cole on atomic energy matters. The Director approved.
