Mr. Dulles:

a. Referred to a proposed bill, which has passed the House and is now before the Senate, providing for registration with the Department of Justice of individuals who have received training in foreign schools for sabotage, espionage, counter-espionage, etc., and stated that while CIA could request exemptions from the provisions of this act, in the national interest, if there were any misgivings on the part of DD/P he (DCI) would personally call Senator Ferguson. Messrs. Wisner and [redacted] undertook to review the bill. 25X1

b. Noted the briefing being held today for Major General George Honnen, who is to replace General Timberman as the U.S. Commander in Berlin, and stated we should have him to lunch before he departs. [redacted] undertook to arrange this. 25X1

c. Reported [redacted] to see him recently. General Cabell noted that [redacted] had also been in to offer his services in this area. The Director asked DD/P to keep these people in mind in the event the situation would warrant their use. Mr. Kirkpatrick pointed out that [redacted] was also well-qualified for an assignment in [redacted]. 25X1

d. Noted [redacted] had requested that [redacted] be assigned to his staff. Mr. Sheldon said [redacted] is now performing a most important function for CIA and he would hate to lose him. After some discussion the Director asked Mr. Sheldon to take this matter up with [redacted] and if it is determined we cannot release [redacted] we should attempt to find another qualified individual for this assignment. 25X1
