Mr. Dulles:

a. Noted that [redacted] had suggested a closer arrangement between CIA and the FBI on the development [redacted] [redacted] The Director said we must assume that the Bureau is engaged in this activity and, therefore, we should offer to pool resources in order to save needless expenditure of Government funds. It was agreed that we should approach the FBI on this subject and [redacted] (1) undertook to do so with Sam Papich; (2) advise [redacted] of the results of the discussion.


