


Mr. Dulles:

a. Noted that Jim Hagerty habitually called him at 0900 on the days the President holds a Press Conference for the purpose of being filled-in on any last-minute information which would be of assistance to the President. Mr. Amory suggested that on these days [redacted] brief the Director at 0845 on matters of interest. The Director approved and stated that DD/P should also keep this in mind and bring to his attention any pertinent information. The Director also asked DD/I to get in touch with Colonel Goodpasture and offer to brief him in preparing for any special meetings the President might have, such as that recently held with Senator Knowland regarding the Offshore Islands situation.
