Mr. Dulles:

a. Stated Col. Goodpaster had recommended that we keep the President advised on the current Egyptian - Israeli situation in the same manner as we handled Korea. The Director agreed with Mr. Sheldon's suggestion that he work the mechanics of this out with Col. Goodpaster and also that the reports "be put to bed" at 5:00 P.M. each day. The Director also asked DD/P to designate a representative to work with OCI in order that complete information is available from both sides of the house.
