Mr. Dulles:

a) Noted he had received a project requesting a substantial increase in TSS funds for research and development and since all members of the PRC were not in complete agreement he had asked [redacted] to be present to discuss this proposal. The Director said he did not like to mortgage the future and would prefer to channel any savings effected on other projects to essential programs based on Agency-wide needs. After considerable discussion it was agreed that: 1) approval would be granted not to exceed \$1,000,000 for those programs now in being and which would expire on 30 June 1957 for lack of funds; 2) the remaining R&D programs contained in the above-mentioned request would receive a fair share of any savings which might be effected in the DD/P area -- Messrs. Wisner and [redacted] to make a decision as to allotment. [redacted] undertook to re-submit to the Director this program with the changes noted above for final approval.
