DEPUTIES' MEETING

Wednesday, 28 May 1958

Mr. Dulles:

a) Noted a letter he had received from the Vice President in which [redacted]
[redacted] was commended for the excellence of his briefing given the
Vice President during his recent trip to South America and stated consideration
should be given to promoting [redacted] from GS-14 to GS-15.

b) Asked DD/P to review the [redacted] situation in light of the current
elections in [redacted]

c) Asked DD/P to send an operational immediate cable [redacted] requesting
[redacted] views on the current [redacted] elections.

Mr. Wisner:

Noted he had prepared a memorandum of a recent conversation he had
with Franc Primozic and commented that the Jugs intend to invite [redacted]
[redacted] to participate in the "Fourth of July Yugoslav celebration of that
country's victory over the Russians". Mr. Wisner said he thought it would be
profitable for these people to attend this meeting and in order to do so it might be
necessary for the Agency to furnish some financial assistance. The Director
agreed.

Mr. Kirkpatrick:

a) Noted that Mr. Macy of the Bureau of the Budget had made three
attempts to obtain a copy of the IG Survey on the FE Division. The Director made
it clear that this survey would not be released to Macy. He said he based this on
the fact that I. G. surveys are prepared for CIA internal use and would not be made
available outside the Agency with the exception of the President's Board of
Consultants.

b) Commented it might be well to send instructions to [redacted] 25X1
pertaining to [redacted] the current situation in [redacted] 25X1

He said at that time nothing was done about it. He said he would urge that this matter be considered and thought given as to Agency plans should some form of disarmament come about. The Director approved. ACTION: DD/P.
