

SUBJECT: Senior Staff Meeting, 18 November 1963

3. General Carter introduced Carl Duckett as Chief of the Foreign Missile and Space Analysis Center.

Mr. Cooper then mentioned that the National Policy Papers (previously called Strategic Studies Program) are now receiving the backing of the White House, and their preparation is going on with vigor. Papers on [redacted] are in the works. General Carter mentioned that he had not previously been satisfied with Agency procedures for coordinating these papers within the Agency for DCI approval before final approval at the State or White House level. General Carter instructed Ray Cline to take on the responsibility of coordinating these papers within the Agency.


25X1 6. After introducing [redacted] General Carter had to leave the meeting in order to see the Director. Ray Cline took over.

9. Mr. Echols mentioned that the UGF goal had been exceeded by \$2000 with 300 cards yet to be tallied. He mentioned the PSAS Drive at Headquarters had brought in an all-time high but that the Field contribution had not yet been received.

10. Mr. Echols also mentioned that only one nomination for the Arthur F. Fleming Award had been received. This is given to men under 40 years of age for specific accomplishments.
