

a. Called the Director's attention to Item 1 in the CIB of 5 August, and stated that action is going ahead to obtain additional information on this subject.


b. Noted there was a good deal of evidence that the Soviets may be in the process of demobilizing some of their troops and, if this is true, it carries out Khrushchev's statement to take such action. However, in effect, demobilization could well mean a realignment of the Soviet forces in connection with their increased proficiency in the missile field.
