DEPUTIES' MEETING

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MR. AMORY:

Noted that the plan to exchange DD/I and DD/P Reports Officers had about slowed to a halt. He said he could understand there might be a reluctance on the part of DD/P personnel to serve a tour with DD/I in view of their feeling that they would lose out on promotions, good future assignments, etc. He commented that in his opinion if this plan is to succeed, the DD/P and DD/I should designate, by name, blank number of exchangees. Action: Mr. Helms undertook to look into this matter.

MR. DULLES:

a. Noted a State cable from Taipei (No. 1215) and asked DD/P to see if there is anything that this Agency can do in assisting the evacuation of the remnants of Li Mi's troops from Burma.

b. Noted he had not seen any reports from the CIA representative in [redacted] and was advised by DD/P that these reports are cranked in to those emanating from [redacted]. The Director said he considered this a most critical area and suggested that it might be worthwhile for [redacted] [redacted] in order to ensure full and complete information on the situation there is being reported.

d. Noted a memorandum from DD/I concerning the Photo Interpretation program and stated that from its contents, it might appear that there is considerable duplication in this field. It was agreed that at an early USIB meeting this matter would be discussed and, as a result of this discussion, a paper ~~sh~~ould be circulated to the members of the Board for its consideration.
