Monday, 16 July 1951

Mr. Reber reported that Admiral Johnson wants to set up an inter-agency committee to determine priorities for covert field collection. Reber will discuss this with SO.

25X1 [redacted] Asked Reber to talk to Air Force once more and make sure that [redacted] will not want to discuss the Atomic paper at the next IAC meeting.

25X1 Talked to Reber again about our contribution to NSC 68/4. He will discuss this with [redacted] and then talk to State Department and the Services not to FBI and AEC.

25X1 [redacted] informed me that any JCS policy papers of interest to us will be hand carried to [redacted] to read but will not be left with him. [redacted] will keep PC informed through [redacted] 25X1 [redacted] I will speak to [redacted] and get him to tell General Huebner that this is approved. 25X1
