Talked with Mr. Owsley, State Department, about a paper which he believes that we have in regard to a meeting in 1949 of a panel to discuss U.S. policy in the Far East. [redacted] is looking for this and will send it to Mr. Owsley.

Mr. Babbitt came in to talk about the Russian atomic blast. Advised him that it was too early for details and that we could only say that we were convinced that it had taken place.
