

The White House has confirmed arrangements for meeting in Washington of the Governors' Conference Civil Defense Committee with the President and key Cabinet members from 9 to 11 a.m., May ninth. Purpose: to review with the President a program for Federal and State cooperative action to achieve fallout protection for all Americans and to accelerate recovery of the nation following a nuclear attack.

I plan to arrange a dinner and business meeting of the Committee at 6:00 p.m., May eighth at my residence, 2500 Foxhall Road, Washington, to discuss our draft program. I hope you can be present for both meetings.


