SUBJECT : General Charles A. Willoughby

1. The Deputy Director (Plans) has received for action a communication from General Willoughby to the Director for Central Intelligence in which General Willoughby states that he is now ready to begin turning over to CIA any and all documentation, which he has, which has still some bearing on the situation in Japan and Korea, such as estimates, briefs, etc., as well as extra copies of the Sorge story.

2. The Deputy Director (Plans) requests your views on the office which should be responsible for reviewing this material to determine items of value to CIA as well as on what arrangements which should be made to pick up any material of value to CIA so that a reply may be dispatched to General Willoughby.
