SUBJECT: Resume of OCB Luncheon Meeting, 9 January 1957

PRESENT: Mr. Hoover, Mr. Dulles, Mr. Gray, Mr. Cutler,  
Mr. Larson, Mr. Staats

1. Lebanon and Iraq

DCI and others urged that, even in advance of the develop-  
ment of the President's program for the Near East, we do what  
we can to strengthen the defenses of the countries neighboring  
Syria, especially Lebanon and Iraq. Mr. Gray felt that we should  
proceed immediately with radar for Iraq.


3. W. L. White's Book on Brainwashing

Mr. Hoover called attention to the unhappiness of Mr.  
White, who, at the instigation of OCB, had undertaken to write  
a book exposing communist brainwashing. Upon its completion  
claims were made that Mr. White had used the material of Col.  
Hansen's <sup>at Defense</sup> ~~book~~ and there was a threat of legal action. White  
revised his book and now asks for assurance from State and  
Defense that he <sup>may proceed with publication</sup> ~~will not be accused of plagiarism~~. Mr. Gray,  
who was unfamiliar with the matter, requested time to look into  
it and promised to report at a subsequent meeting.




